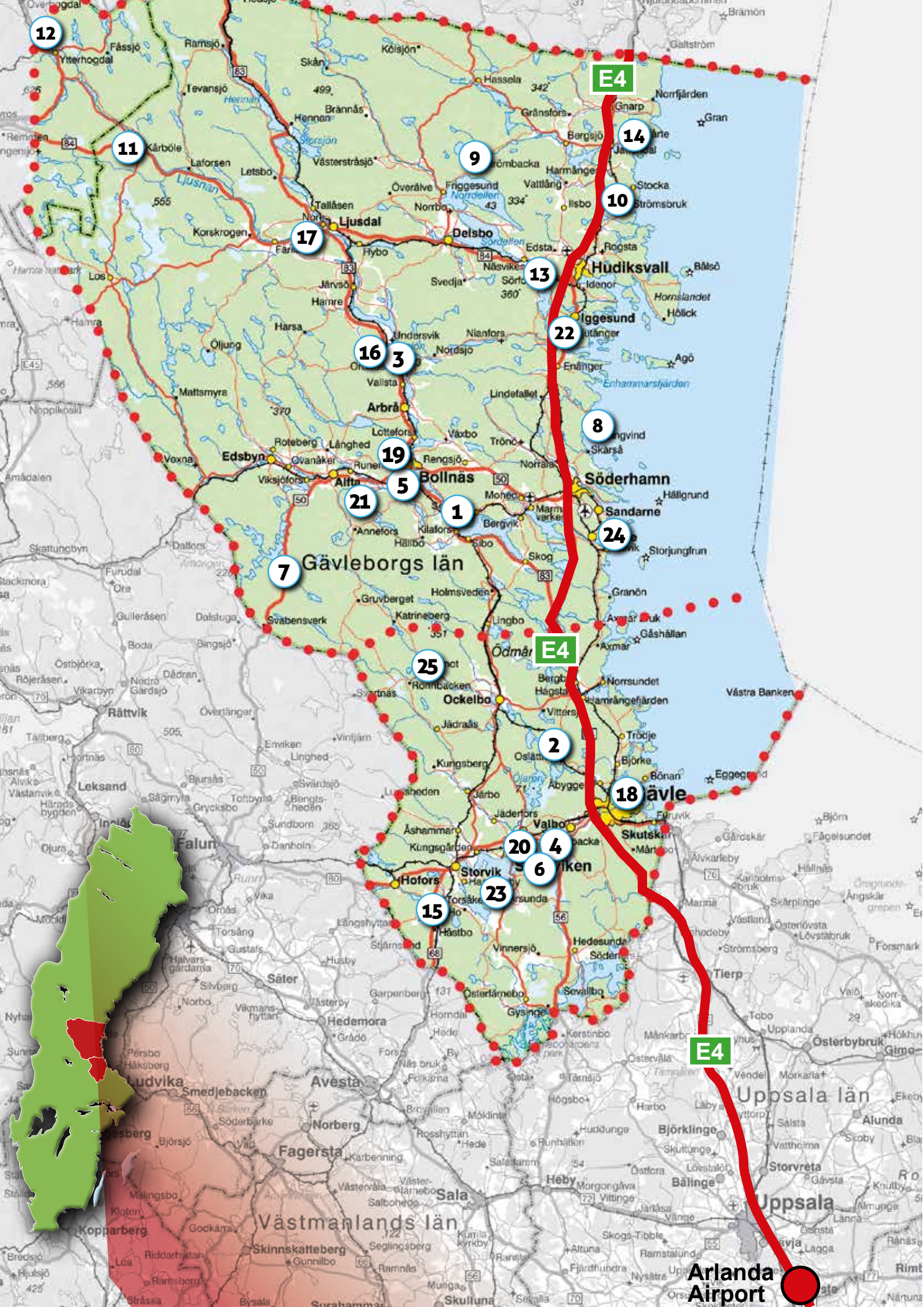

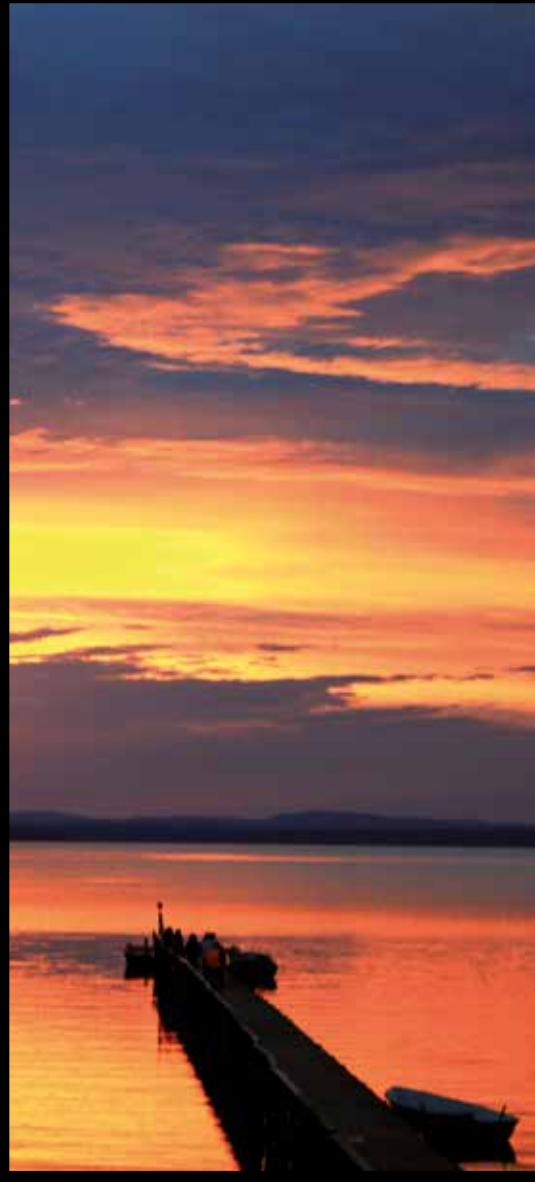

# Central Sweden

The neighbouring districts of Hälsingland and Gästrikland are located in central Sweden. These two areas are geographically very similar. In the east, along the coastal areas they border the Baltic Sea, and in the West, there are large forests and many lakes, rivers and streams. As a result, the fishing is therefore extremely varied here. One day, you can catch salmon and sea trout and the next day you can catch pike, zander or perch. Or why not try to catch a nice salmon trout or grayling in one of our healthy and flourishing waters.

A trip to these areas is a release from the hustle and bustle of the big cities and the traffic.

Here you will encounter bird song, the whistling of the wind and the lapping of the water against the boats. A recurring question posited by satisfied tourists is – how can there be so few people in such a beautiful area?

For those who want to do more than just fish, there are a variety of activities on offer. You can visit an amusement park, an animal park, a sporting event, cultural and historic venues, you can paddle a canoe, visit a whisky distillery or go hiking in the woods on a “predator tour” for example.

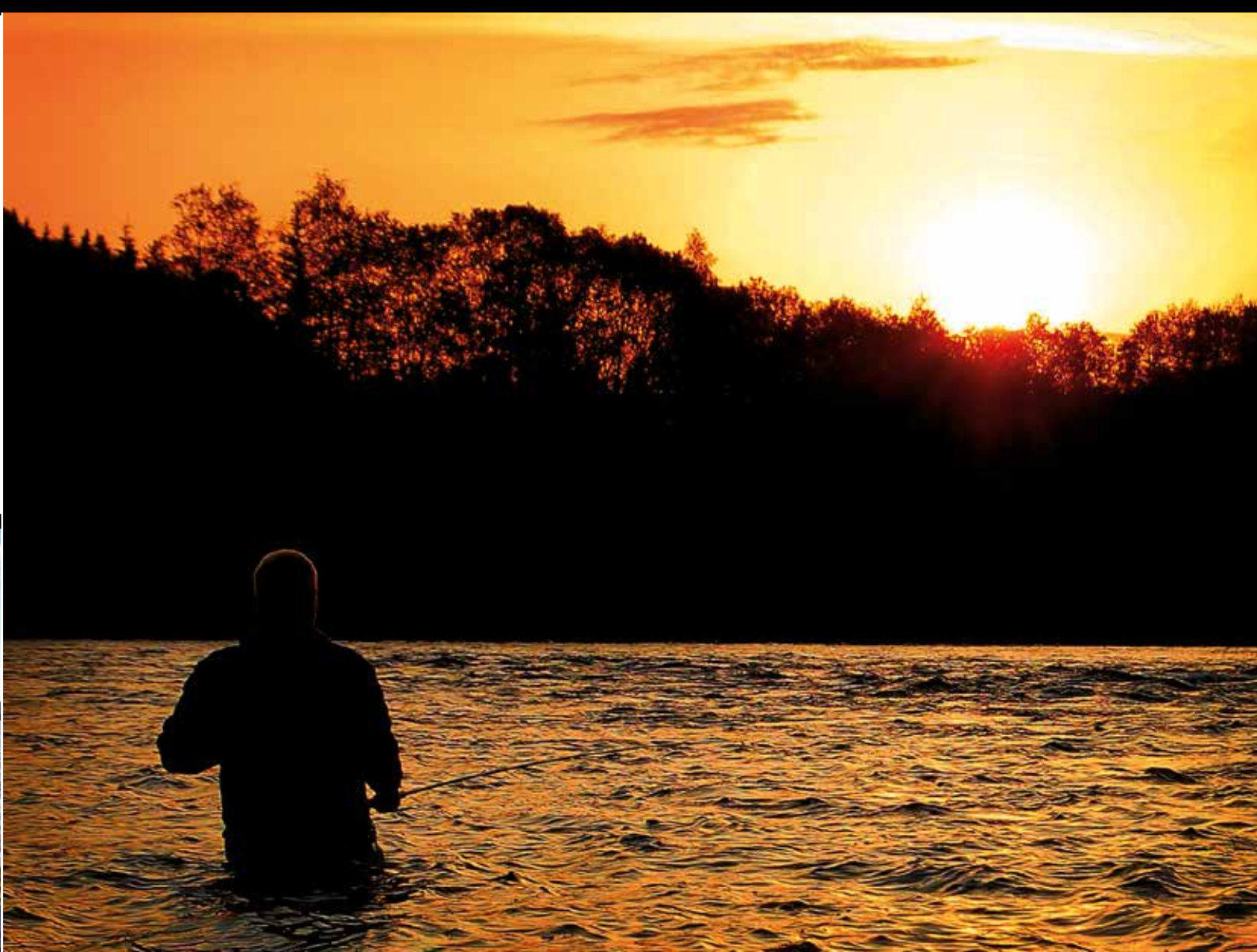
In short, you will certainly find what you are looking for in terms of both fishing and adventure.

You can easily get to the various areas because the distances are relatively short, and the traffic is light. Within the space of a few minutes you can get from one fishing ground to another. There is also an extensive network of trains and buses.

A few examples of distances from Arlanda by car:

Approximately 1.5 hours to Gävle, 2.5 hours to Bollnäs and 3 hours to Hudiksvall.





# Facts about our species

Here is some information about species found in our area.

## Perch

**(Perca fluviatilis) Maximum length and weight is about 50 cm and 2 kg.**

Perch is found in almost all lakes and rivers in our area. It is very enjoyable to fish, as it is often eager to bite. Spinner, wobbler, spoon and jig work well, but you can also use live bait or fly fish for perch.

With its mild flavour perch is excellent for eating.

The best season from July to August, but perch can be fished all year with good results.



## Silver bream

**(Blicca bjoerkna) Maximum length and weight is about 45 cm and 1.4 kg.**

Silver bream is a common in the area. For the most part it grows in the sea and swims upstream in running waters in both spring and fall. Once there, it is usually easy to catch with bottom or vertical fishing. Many magnificent examples have been caught in our waters. The Swedish record is in danger every spring and fall when specimen fishermen are in the hunt.



## Bream

**(Abramis brama) Maximum length and weight is about 70 cm and 5 kg.**

Bream can grow especially big in many of our lakes, but also in rivers and bays along the coast wherever weed is abundant.

Bream are mostly caught using worms, maggots or corn, but there are days when spinners or spoons work well. The season is April through September.



## Brown Trout / Lake Trout

**(Salmo trutta lacustris) Maximum length and weight is about 90 cm and 7 kg.**

With its lovely, often coloured spots, the brown trout is a very beautiful, colourful fish.

Brown trout are found in many small rivers and lakes with good quality water and are caught using fly, spin or bait. It bites throughout the year, but the best periods are spring and autumn.

Brown trout is as beautiful on the table as in the wild, frequently with a red / pink colour and a superb taste.



## Pike

**(Esox lucius) Maximum length and weight is about 125 cm and 15 kg.**

Pike is one of our strongest, most aggressive fishes. It lives in most of our lakes, rivers and along the coast, thriving in places where there are lots of small fish. Pike takes spoons, wobbler, jig, bait and fly making it a fish that many love to spend time trying to catch. There are lots of places where you can find pike over the magic limit of 100 cm. Pike can be caught throughout the year with different peaks depending on where you fish. In short, it is everywhere, strikes on everything and is BIG.

It is almost exclusively a Catch & Release species, because people know it's worth more in the water than on the table.



## Pikeperch

**(Sander lucioperca) Maximum length and weight is about 95 cm and 10 kg.**

Pikeperch is an excellent sports fish that bites on everything or nothing. It has well defined eating periods when fishing can be superb and then suddenly there is nothing. This is one of the reasons why many people spend a lot of time on pikeperch fishing. It is mostly a lake fish, but is also found in some rivers. Our waters offer great opportunities for catching your dream fish - every year pikeperch weighing as much as 9 kg are taken here. Pikeperch fishing was previously confined to the period from May through August, but today more and more people fish all year for this tricky fish.

Good techniques are trolling, vertical jigging, coarse fishing with live bait and of course spinning. Pikeperch is often found in the deep water and can be a bit difficult to catch with fly equipment.

As food pikeperch is much appreciated, leading to the need for sustainable fishing, for not keeping more than one or two fishes at a time.





## Grayling

(*Thymallus thymallus*) Maximum length and weight is about 55 cm and 2 kg.

Grayling is found in small numbers along the coast, but thrives in lakes, streams and rivers with good water quality. It is a lovely fish with a mighty "sail" on its back. The grayling is a very fun species to fly fish, but you can also use spin or bait with good results, as the fish is often willing to bite.

Grayling can be caught all year, but is at its best when it's hatching periods. Then grayling will happily take a dry fly



## Sea trout

(*Salmo trutta trutta*) Maximum length and weight is about 95 cm and 10 kg.

As the name suggests, the sea trout lives in the sea and is mostly caught there. However, there are some exceptions. During two periods of the year sea trout migrate up in our streams and rivers. These periods tend to vary in time depending on how far north you are, but occur mainly from April to May and August to October. During these periods, sea trout is caught on the fly, with spoons and spinners.

Along the coast, it's about the same methods, but one can also add coarse fishing with bait, as well as trolling.

Sea trout are very active, beautiful and delicious. But its very popularity makes it necessary to protect the fish population by releasing most of the individuals caught.



## Orfe (Ide)

(*Leuciscus idus*) Maximum length and weight is about 65 cm and 3 kg.

This is one of the most popular specimen species found in our area. Some individuals can be very large. The ide is mostly caught using natural baits such as worms, maggots, corn and shrimp, but it takes spoons or spinners too.

Ide are found in most lakes, streams and rivers, but also along the coast. They wander into our coastal running waters during spring and autumn providing the best chance to catch large specimens.



## Salmon

(*Salmo salar*) Maximum length and weight is about 130 cm and 28 kg.

Salmon is a much-appreciated food fish. It wanders up along our coast when the spawning period approaches. June-July is our top season, trolling offshore and fly- or spin-fishing when it arrives in the rivers. The lovely, silver-dressed salmon is the largest, strongest species we have in our area. Individuals weighing nearly 30 kg have been caught here and aggressive, hard-to-land salmon have broken many rods (and fishermen). While it's not easy to get it to strike, if it does it's far from certain that you can land it. It's torpedo-shaped, powerful body makes it very difficult to stop and master.



## Rudd

(*Rutilus erythrophthalmus*) Maximum length and weight is about 50 cm and 1.6 kg.

Rudd is one of the most beautiful specimen species available with their golden glistening body and blood-red fins. Rudd is found in most lakes and rivers, but the biggest specimens are often caught in coastal bays or rivers with access to the sea and plenty of vegetation and weeds. Coarse fishing is the primary method for catching rudd with corn, maggots and worms the most rewarding baits.

Many rudd close to the Swedish record weight have been caught here. It is very strong for its size and therefore appreciated as a specimen species.



## Lavaret

(*Coregonus lavaretus*) Maximum length and weight is about 50 cm and 2 kg.

The lavaret lives in the sea, lakes and streams. The stock in the sea is much reduced and therefore should not be fished there. However, there is a good stock of lavaret in our lakes and rivers and it is a popular, tasty fish. Lavaret can be caught by coarse fishing, fly or jig, although all whitefish can sometimes take a spinner or spoon. The best places to catch lavaret are in the northern part of our area.



## Vimba

(*Abramis vimba*) Maximum length and weight is about 45 cm and 1.3 kg.

Vimba is a highly ranked species among the specimen hunters. The big bump on the nose makes it hard to mistake it for other species. It is very strong for its size and rises up in our streams and rivers from April to June. Vimba is captured best by bottom fishing in running water using shrimp, maggots and worms. There are few reports of vimba caught in the sea or lakes.

The Swedish weight record has been broken several times in our area.





# Kungsholmen

The Kungsholmen Restaurant & Conference is a unique facility in the midst of Hälsingland Province's lovely nature dating back to the timber rafting period in the 1800s. Kungsholmen lies on an island in the Ljusnan River valley with only a footbridge connecting it to the shore and is owned by the famous Swedish cross country skiers Erik and Billan Östlund. Here you can enjoy a superb nature, excellent food and relaxation in a restful, familiar setting. We offer singular, all-year fishing experiences limited only by your own imagination.

## Season

We hold an all-year season. Though pikeperch fishing is best during the summer, perch and pike can be caught all year. In the winter we offer angling and ice fishing for various species.

## Species & Records

Pikeperch fishing is best in the spring and summer with the most effective method being vertical jigging from an anchored boat. Pike can be fished all year, but the best seasons for catching large ones are spring and autumn. Perch can also be fished all year, but is exceptional during early and peak summer. Biggest pikeperch from lake Bergviken, 7,2 kg.

## Fishing Service

We have spinning rods and a selection of baits for sale. work closely with Andy's Fishing Guide in providing a guide boat completely equipped with fishing and safety equipment for trolling and spin-fishing after pike, perch, pikeperch and brown trout. This is a Tracker V17 (18 x 2 m) fitted with a 40 hp Suzuki 4-stroke motor, fish finder and GPS. Your rental boat for own fishing: 5 meter Storbåda with 25 hp 4-stroke Tohatsu motor. Also possible to rent: 3 Linder 440, 1.64 m wide, with a 5 hk Suzuki outboard, electric motor, oars, fish finder and trailer.

## Location & Transfer

The Kungsholmen Restaurant & Conference is located in Segersta between Söderhamn and Bollnäs. The site is 280 km NW of Arlanda International Airport and Stockholm is around three hours away by car





## Equipment & tactics

In Lake Bergviken where we fish spin and cast dominate during spring, summer and autumn, and ice fishing in the winter. Lures used for pikeperch, pike and perch include variously sized jigs, as well as both large and small wobblers of various types.

## Regulations

You must have a fishing licence to fish in lakes and waterways, and you must have a special licence for trolling. The fishing licences are personal and may not be transferred. While we promote catch and release (C&R), you may keep up to three fish per day and person. However, the following minimum measurements must be observed: trout and char – 30 cm, grayling – 35 cm and pikeperch – 50 cm. Fishing in running water is forbidden from September 1 to December 31.

## Other activities

There are many other things to do when not fishing including a wood-fired hot tub and a sauna, clay-pigeon shooting, cross-country skiing, four-wheel riding, JärvZoo, the Enchanted Forest, Norrigården and more. For an extra touch we can pull the Arken fishing hut out on the ice complete with wood stove and bar. We also have canoes for rent.

## Languages

At Kungsholmen Restaurant & Conference we speak Swedish and English.

## Accommodation

We have beds for as many as 44 persons in 21 rooms and two traditional cabins (härbre). Most rooms have their own fireplace and were built during the timber rafting period. Shower and WC can be found in the main building. You can also rent the fully equipped 8-bed villa 'Flottarvillan' located on the shore near Kungsholmen, just by the bridge leading to the island. In 'Flottarvillan' you can choose between self catering or full board at Kungsholmen restaurant. Also available is Villa 'Kjell-Johan' located aprox 3 km from Kungsholmen. Those who wish to live in spartan simplicity without electricity or water can rent a summer pasturage transhumance cabin.

## Swescot

Swescot in Ockelbo specializes in combining glorious fishing experiences with other traditional activities within reasonable driving distance. We are open year-round and offer overnights in modern, newly renovated cabins. The fish variation is great as most everything is but an hour away by car when you stay in our cabins. Just in our district the species range includes perch, pike, pikeperch, brown trout and rainbow, plus salmon and ocean trout only a short distance away.

### Season

Swescot is open all year, lending itself to all-season fishing. Boat fishing is available after the ice has melted until it freezes over again, meaning March/April to November/December. We offer ice-fishing as soon as the ice can bear, meaning November/December through March/April.

### Species & Records

In our local waters you will find several interesting species, Perch – 2.0 kg/around 50 cm, Pike – 10 kg, Pikeperch – 6 kg in Lake Bysjö, Salmon – 27 kg in the Dalälven River, Sea trout – 10 kg in the Dalälven River.

### Fishing Service

The cabins are situated some 500 metres from the Testeboån River and a boat is part of the cost. A rowboat with oars, life jackets, casting and angling rods are included. A 4 hp motor can be rented. Fishing is done led by experienced guides in the water of your choice. Fishing sites for the species of your choice can be found nearby.

### Location & Transfer

Ockelbo is located; app. 2 hrs N of Arlanda Airport (180 km) – mostly on motorways, app. 2.5 hrs N of Västerås Airport (185 km), less than 3 hrs N of Nynäshamn (270 km), a bit more than 3 hrs from Skavsta Airport (316 km) – mostly on motorways.

## Regulations

We obey the limits and rules set by the fish preservation areas. We recommend durable fishing, though you may keep fish for your own use.

Berries and mushrooms abound in the woods, child-friendly beach, skiing downhill and cross-country, snow scooters, moose/bear safaris, dog sled, professional ice hockey, top level bandy and soccer, sauna, hot-tub, sledding, grill cot, whiskey distillery, Vikings.

### Location & Transfer

### Equipment & tactics

Spring – spin, jerk and trolling for pike, spin and trolling for brown trout.

Summer – spin and trolling for pike and brown trout.

Autumn – spin, jerk and trolling for pike.

Winter – ice-fishing for perch; angling and ice-fishing for pike.

### Regulations

Fishing licence must be carried during all fishing.

Pike-perch may not be taken in the Ljusnan River during June. All caught must be returned without exception.

### Other activities

If you have any time over we recommend the Järv-zoo and the five large predators, a horse and buggy tour or Växbo Lin flax shop with a factory store. In addition there is a wonderful sand beach (Hälsingland Riviera), hiking trails and more.

### Fishing Service

### Location & Transfer

Forsbacka village is located by lake Storsjön between Gävle and Sandviken. Distances; 1.5 hrs N of Arlanda Airport, 15 km/20 min from Gävle train station and 7 km/10 min from Sandviken. From Stockholm E4/R80/E16 – Stockholm 200 km, Örebro 250 km, Sundsvall 230 km.







## Equipment & tactics

Spin and casting from a boat is the most common fishing method here. Trolling can also provide good catches. We recommend spring fishing for pike using jerkbait, spin fly or fly-fishing. Pikeperch fishing is best in the summer and autumn, but even ice-fishing is top class. The best results are achieved with wobbler, jig or live bait, but trolling and vertical jigging are also very successful.

## Regulations

The daily limit for pike and pikeperch is three per day, but we recommend taking only one fish a day for eating. The pikeperch min/max is 45-65 cm, while for pike the max is 75 cm.

Pleasant living in an estate setting, close to a number of lakes and running water teeming with pike, brown trout, perch and pike perch. We are located where the Ljusnan and Voxnan rivers flow together in a country setting just outside Bollnäs, but still near shopping, playgrounds and beaches. You choose yourself if you want to eat in our restaurant or fix your own food in the kitchen.

### Season

We are open all year. Pike is best in the autumn, winter and spring, while perch and pikeperch bite best between June and August. Brown trout is best winter and spring.

### Species & Records

Several of the lakes, including Varpen, Marmen, Upper and Lower Herten, are home to pike as heavy as 13 kg, pikeperch at 6 kg, trout at 2 kg and perch at 2 kg.

### Fishing Service

### Season

Frägsta is open all year, even offering fishing on the winter ice. Trolling in open water is also available accompanied by guides. When the ice is thick enough, we turn to ice-fishing.

### Species & Records

Brown trout are continuously stocked in our trolling waters. Pike is also readily available. Trophy fish include brown trout at 9.2 kg and pike at 22 kg. Ice-fishing is done on lakes with stocked fish, mainly rainbow and char.

### Fishing Service

In cooperation with professional guides we can offer trolling from a 6.40 m Nordsjö WalkAround boat equipped with two Suzuki motors, one at 140 hp and the other at 15 hp, fully equipped for trolling. The maximum party is 6 persons. The boat is fitted with autopilot, GPS navigation, communication radio and electronic sea charts.

Alpine char in Lake Hälsen: ice-fishing, angling and lure-fishing from 25/12 until freezing. Pike in Lake Dellen: trolling from the end of May through Oct 15. Pike in the Forsa lakes: trolling and vertical fishing from the end of May through Oct 15. Pikeperch in the Forsa lakes: trolling and vertical fishing from May through August 15. Sea trout in the Baltic Sea: trolling from the end of May through June 15 + autumn. Salmon in the Baltic Sea: trolling from the end of May through July 15. Rainbow in lakes Ysen and Mjusen: ice-fishing, angling and lure-fishing all year. Brown trout in Lake Dellen: trolling from May through November.

### Regulations

When trolling you may catch no more than three brown trout per boat with a minimum measurement of 45 cm. There is no limit to the number of pike you catch. You may only catch three game fish per licence when ice-fishing. Once three have been killed, the licence is used up.

### Other activities

## Equipment & tactics

Ljusdal Fishery Conservation Area - minimum size: grayling – 40 cm; trout – 40 cm. Max 4 fish per day.  
Färila Fishery Conservation Area - grayling; only possible to keep fish between min 25 cm and max 30 cm. Trout minimum 40 cm. Max 4 fish per day.

During the summer you can also visit: Järvzoo animal park at Järvsö, an excursion for the whole family and those interested in animals ([www.jarvzoo.se](http://www.jarvzoo.se)); Stenegård, a protected manor and farm, is also popular with the whole family. Järvsö is about 30 km from the camp. Another goal is the mountain bike course.
